Reconnex students are invited to return to school for scheduled attendance. In-school time will be dedicated to providing students assistance and support with their learning. Students who attend school may also continue to learn remotely during week. Students, both in school and at home, can continue to be in touch with Reconnex staff at any time during school hours; however, with the return to face to face learning, staff may not be immediately available. Please know that your child's return to school is voluntary and remote learning will continue.

Our return to school will look vastly different than when we left in March. The safety of our students and staff is our priority; therefore, a number of safety measures have been implemented.

1. Parents are responsible for checking the health of their child(ren) daily before school.
If your child is ill, or shows any symptoms such as fever, coughing, sneezing, runny nose, it is imperative that you keep them at home.
Students who become ill or develop any of the above symptoms at school will be isolated and a parent/guardian will be called and required to pick the student up as quickly as possible.
2. Students will assemble 2 metres apart at the front entrance of the school at their assigned time and be given a health screening (questions regarding their health).
If there are any concerns regarding a student's health, the student will not be allowed in the building and the student's parent/guardian will be contacted to pick up the student. If you are dropping your child off at school, we recommend that you wait in your vehicle in the parking lot until your child has passed the health screening and has been permitted inside.
3. Assuming the health screening is satisfactory and the student is able to enter the school, the student will have to wash their hands before being led to their assigned workspace.

Each workspace has an occupancy limit and the student, with at least one staff member, will remain in this space for the duration of the student's time. Tables have been set up to allow for appropriate social distancing.

Students may not bring any food or drink into the building, and all students are encouraged to use the washroom prior to coming to school.

At the end of the session the student will wash their hands and then be walked to their assigned exit by and will leave the school property immediately.
